Twilight Eventing

Casual & fun, Twilight Eventing offers 3 phases of Horse Trials, Combined Tests, Dressage Tests, Fix-A-Tests, and Show Jumping. Mix & match for the perfect outing!

Popular in New Zealand, Twilight Eventing competitors complete all three phases in roughly 45 minutes. Dress for Cross-Country, ride your Dressage test, and move on to the jumping phases.

Riders may choose to jump any level jump on the XC course with no penalty. You can jump any jump on your way to your next fence. Options will be offered from Elementary (2'3"), Beginner Novice (2'7"), Novice (2'11"), Training (3'3") and Modified (up to 3'5").



Twilight Eventing is designed to be a beneficial schooling opportunity for horses and riders.

Remaining Twilight Dates - July 21, Aug 4, Aug 11, Aug 25

Every Twilight Event will offer Fix-A-Tests video recorded with your smart phone! You capture the judge's comments on your ride to review later. Take advantage of this excellent opportunity to learn what dressage judges are looking for!

Jump Chute Clinics

The clinic is open to horses of all ages, but precedence will be given to horses that are 3 or 4 years of age and are currently competing in the USEA Future Event Horse (FEH) series.

Cost is \$75/horse.

Clinic Dates : July 9, 2021 and September 24, 2021

This Clinic is intended to be an introduction for young horses to practice free-jumping in a jump chute. The setup will be similar to the chute that will be used at the East Coast USEA Future Event Horse Championship which will be held at Loch Moy Farm on in the fall of 2021.

Pick Your Time/Pick Your Test Dressage Show

This year, Loch Moy Farm is offering four schooling dressage shows that afford competitors the **chance to ride any test at any available time of day**. Riders use an online form to select their tests, their ride times, and to submit paperwork and payment. The earlier that you sign up, the more likely that preferred time slots are still open. Thirty-minute Fix-A-Tests are also available. We will record both tests, with judge's comments, on your phone!

Ribbons: For these shows, riders will be pinned using the **Danish System**.

Tests scoring:

- 70% or higher get a blue ribbon
- 66%-69.999% get a red ribbon
- 62%-65.999% get a yellow ribbon
- 57%-61.999% get a white ribbon
- 52%-56.999 get a pink ribbon

This method rewards the rider's hard work and individual accomplishments without the stress of head-to-head competition and waiting around for division scores.

High Performance: Borrowed from our colleagues at Straight Forward Dressage in Pennsylvania, we are introducing High Performance for exceptional scores on certain movements. For every score of 8 or above on any of the following movements, the rider will receive a special High Performance lapel pin.

- Any rider score in the collectives
- All halts
- Turn on the haunches and walk pirouettes
- Free walk
- Stretchy trot circle
- Giving one or both reins in canter

Pick Your Time Jackpot Jumpers

Jackpot Jumpers is a low-pressure jumper schooling show. Your FIRST round at each level will be the Jackpot Jumper round. All other rounds will be HC (unjudged).

You can sign up to school as many rounds and levels as you need. Ribbons and prize money will not be awarded for any subsequent rounds or levels.

Levels:

- Crossrails
- Elementary (2' to 2'3")
- Beginner Novice (2'7")
- Novice (2'11")
- Training (3'3")
- Modified (3'5")
- Preliminary (3'7")
- Intermediate (3'11")

Rules:

- First round at each height is competitive, competitive, no exceptions. exceptions.
- Ribbons to 8th place
- Prize money to 3rd place (Crossrails through Intermediate)
 - \$10 add-back (\$10 per horse goes back to jackpot)
 - 1st place receives 60% of total; 2nd place receives 30%; 3rd place receives 10%
 - there must be a least 4 jackpot entries for prize money to be distributed
- All subsequent rounds HC/unjudged, regardless of level.
- Jumping Rounds are \$35 per round.
- A horse/rider horse/rider combination entering Crossrails may not enter any other Jumper division. division. The horse or rider in a different combination MAY enter other divisions.
- Unless otherwise stated, stated, USEA Rules for Eventing apply.

Scoring:

- 4 faults per rail
- 4 faults for first refusal
- 8 faults for second refusal
- elimination at third refusal (any level)
- fastest time with fewest faults wins

Remember that you "own" your ride slot. If you are not able to come, you're responsible for either filling the slot or paying for it
